

2024 Student Scholarship: Application Instructions

Submission deadline: Wednesday, April 17, 2024 by 11:59pm

Redmond High School PTSA Scholarships, valued at \$1,000 each, aim to support the educational pursuits of selected graduating seniors. Recipients of these scholarships may allocate the funds exclusively for tuition at a two-year or four-year college, vocational school expenses, mandatory textbooks, or on-campus housing for room and board. The scholarship award must be utilized by December 31, 2024.

The PTSA Scholarship Committee employs a thorough evaluation process based on the following criteria to determine scholarship recipients:

- 1. Extra-curricular and Community Service Activities: Consideration of involvement in extracurricular activities and contributions to the community.
- 2. Academic Excellence and Motivation: Evaluation of academic performance and demonstrated motivation for higher education.
- 3. Essay Responses: Assessment of thoughtful and articulate responses to essay prompts.
- 4. **Future Goals:** Examination of the applicant's aspirations and future educational or career objectives.
- 5. **Demonstrated Determination or Turnaround in High School:** *Recognition of instances where determination or significant improvement has been displayed during high school years.*
- 6. Letters of Recommendation: Submission of letters of recommendation is required and must be received by the specified deadline.
- 7. Correct and Complete Submission of the Application

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Complete the application form and the short answer questions and submit them to scholarships@redmondhsptsa.org.
- 2. Include the following supplemental items:
 - a. Copy of your **high school transcript including the first semester of senior year** and any college courses you have taken. Unofficial copies are acceptable.
 - **TWO letters of recommendation**: at least one from an RHS faculty member who knows you well. The second letter may be from an employer, coach, running start instructor, family friend or other appropriate individual. *Letters from family members will not be accepted*. Recommendation letters may be emailed directly to scholarships@redmondhsptsa.org.
- 3. Please do not submit any additional materials, such as art portfolios or photos, as these will not be considered. ALL SCHOLARSHIP MATERIALS WILL BE KEPT CONFIDENTIAL

 - b. Reflect on the impact of your volunteer work within the community, both in the present and its potential influence on your future
 - c. Explain the factors that led to a positive turnaround in your academic journey, focusing on the role of determination. If there was a specific situation involved, describe how your unwavering determination played a pivotal role in reshaping your focus.
 - d. Provide a description of why you seek to receive this scholarship, outlining your motivations and aspirations for the future
